MAKE YOUR OWN SNOW GLOBE CHRISTMAS CARDS!

Why not make your own magical snow globe cards? Simply follow the steps below to create a unique Christmas card design for your friends and family. Remember to ask an adult to help out when using scissors!

YOU'LL NEED:

2 sheets of A4 card, preferably in different colours

A glue stick

Scissors

A photograph of you and/or your family

Glitter or a white paint pen

Pens or paint pens

STEP I

Fold one sheet of A4 card in half, widthways.

STEP 2

Cut out this shape as the base of your snow globe. Use it as a template to cut the other sheet of coloured card to shape, and use a glue stick to attach it to the front of your card, just below the middle.

STEP3

Cut out this shape as your globe. Use it as a template to cut your photograph to size, then attach your photo-globe to the base on your card.

STEP4

Spread a very thin layer of glue to all or part of your photo, and then using a small pinch of glitter, gently sprinkle it over so that some of it sticks to the photo, to look like snow. Alternatively, you could also use a white paint pen to draw tiny dots on the photo to create the same kind of effect.

STEPS

Add a 'Happy Christmas' message to the top of the card, and any other decoration you like around the edges and inside.

CREATE YOUR OWN UNIQUE MIRACLE ON EBENEZER STREET STYLE DECORATIONS!

Why not make your own unique decorations? Simply follow the steps below to create a purple reindeer and magical snow globe. Remember to ask an adult to help out when using scissors!

YOU'LL NEED:

- 1 sheet of card
- A glue stick
- Scissors
- Ribbon to hang your decoration
- Glitter glue

STEP I

Cut out the shapes below, and use them as templates to cut out the same shape in card

STEP 2

Stick the shapes to the card using the glue stick, then carefully, using a sharp pencil or scissors, create a hole for your ribbon to feed through

STEP 3

Using glitter glue, follow the outline of the shape to give it a decorative edge

STEP 4

Once dried, feed a piece of ribbon through the hole and knot the ends together to make a loop. Now you can hang your decoration up!
