## NO TWO VULVAS LOOK THE SAME

Have you ever looked at your vulva and thought, does this look normal? I've got something **big** to tell you: there's no such thing as normal. Every person's body is different – and that's just as true for vulvas.

Labia minora are probably the most diverse part. They can range from 7 to 50mm in width, and it's not uncommon for them to be even wider than this. They range from 20 to 100mm in length. Sometimes they are big enough to stick out from the labia majora – this is **totally** normal. Often, they are asymmetrical. Mine are!

Labia also massively vary in colour and can be the same colour as the rest of your skin, or be redder, pinker, browner or even a shade of purple! It's super common for labia to change with age – particularly when you go through puberty and menopause – and when you're aroused. They don't change with how much sex you have though! That's a total myth – it's literally impossible to establish someone's sexual history from the appearance of their vulva.

The illustrations on this page are drawn from real people's vulvas. Look how diverse they are!

Take some time to grab a mirror and gaze at your vulva to see how unique and beautiful it really is.
