
A heady, blazing debut psychological thriller about one woman's obsession from US poet sensation Olivia Gatwood.



An A to Z of Assaults on Our Language



An A to Z of terrible English by the Telegraph's former master grammarian.

The English language today is under constant siege. Grammar is regularly mangled; words are frequently misused; sometimes all sense of real meaning is lost. Simon Heffer, for one, feels that enough is enough.

His new A to Z of poor English runs through a whole litany of common confusions ('flaunt' and 'flout', 'imply' and 'infer', 'uninterested' and 'disinterested'), words and phrases used unidiomatically ('fed up of', 'focus around'), and lazy expressions (these days every extended activity is an '-athon', every scandal is a 'Something-gate'). It bemoans some truly awful neologisms, 'infotainment' and 'funwashing' among them. And it registers the horror of those of us who do not believe that you can answer the question 'How are you?' with the words 'I'm good'.

Trenchant and sprinkled with dry wit, Scarcely English is both a chamber of horrors of bad and lazy English and a plea for accuracy, clear thinking and elegance.







His acclaimed autobiography, *Testimony*, was published in 2016.
