Effy learned that when she defeated the Fairy King. She is finally free of her nightmares and has earned a spot at the literature college, making her the first woman in history to enrol.

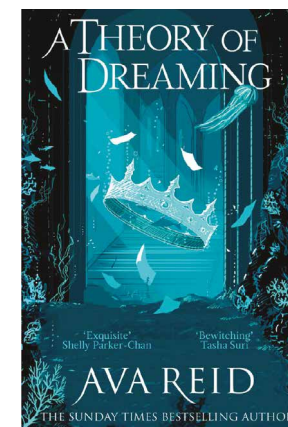
